“That Laois County Council apply to the Department of Transport for funding for resurfacing the R445 (formerly N7) at the Pike of Rushall under ‘Former National Roads’ as part of the 2024 investment programme for regional and local roads to be announced early next year”

“That Laois County Council address the road safety issues at Kirwan’s cross on the L-1619 at Cuddagh, Castletown as a matter of priority”
