4. NOTICE OF MOTIONS

Notice of Motion No: 141/2019

Councillor Seamus McDonald proposed the following Notice of Motion:-

"That Laois County Council make safe the road junction at Sand's, Ballyfin"

This Notice of Motion was seconded by Councillor Paddy Bracken. The Members were advised that The Road Design Section will arrange to meet the Elected member on site to identify the exact location and required safety measures. Once issues are established, the Road Design Section will prepare safety proposals which will be subject to resources being available.

Notice of Motion No: 142/2019

Councillor Seamus McDonald proposed the following Notice of Motion:~

"That Laois County Council give an update regarding the removal of the trees at Camross Cemetery"

These Notice of Motions were seconded by Councillor Conor Bergin. The Members were advised that The Parish Committee sought tenders for these works ~ closing date for receipt of tenders is the 13th of December 2019. The Elected Member will be updated of those shortlisted for safety improvements in early 2020.

"That this Council provide funding for an extension to the footpath from Mountmellick to the Rock National School in the interest of pedestrian safety"

The Members were advised that the Road Design Section will arrange to meet the Elected Member on site to identify the exact location and extent of required footpath. Road Design will prepare design proposals which will be subject to resources being available.

Notice of Motion No: 146/2019

Councillor Paddy Bracken proposed the following Notice of Motion:~

"That this Council provide traffic calming/ ramps at the entrance to Twomey Park, Pattison Estate & Davin Park, Mounmellick"

This Notice of Motion was seconded by Councillor Seamus McDonald. The Members were advised that these ramps will be installed.

Notice of Motion No: 147/2019

Councillor Ollie Clooney proposed the following Notice of Motion:~

"That this Council extends the footpath from opposite the Church to the Graveyard in Shanahoe"

This Notice of Motion was seconded by Councillor Paddy Bracken The Members were advised that Laois County Council will meet with the Councillor on site to establish the need for an extension to the footpath at this location.

Notice of Motion No: 148/2019

Councillor Ollie Clooney proposed the following Notice of Motion:~

"That this Council cleans the River Gully from Ballacolla down to Moyne, Durrow"

This Notice of Motion was seconded by Councillor Conor Bergin. The Members were advised that Laois County Council will meet representatives from Coillte on site regarding the removal of fallen trees from the River Gully channel. The Councillor will be updated on the outcome of this meeting.

Councillor Clooney indicated that this is now a matter of urgency.

Notice of Motion No: 149/2019

Councillor Ollie Clooney proposed the following Notice of Motion:~

"That this Council rectify the drainage problem that has arisen on the N77 in Durrow opposite Woods Shop following the resurfacing works this year."

This Notice of Motion was seconded by Councillor John King. The Members were advised that the Road Section will investigate this drainage issue and will rectify the problem.

Councillor Clooney indicated that there are uneven levels of tarmacadam on this very busy stretch of road and water is flowing downwards.

Notice of Motion No: 150/2019

Councillor John King proposed the following Notice of Motion:~

"That this Council repair a serious hollow on the Kyledellig Clough road which is prone to flooding on an ongoing basis during winter months. This road has been closed on numerous occasions causing disruption to School buses and patrons using this road"

This Notice of Motion was seconded by Councillor Ollie Clooney. The Members were advised that Laois County Council will meet with the Councillor on site to examine the options available in order to solve the flooding issues on this road.

Notice of Motion No: 151/2019

"That this Council support the request from the Principal of St Colmcilles National School, Errill in relation to the need for safety measures such as road markings / flashing beckons / lights and signage in order to make it safe for all attending the School"

The Members were advised that Road Design Section will arrange to meet Elected member and principal of St Colmcilles National School to identify exact location and required safety measures. Once issues are established Road design will prepare safety proposals. This site may also be considered for 2020 CLAR funding application.

"That this Council give a commitment for 2020 to install a pedestrian crossing and flashing beckons at St Fergals College Rathdowney to ensure safety for all children and adults attending School and using playground and walking track on a daily basis"
