“That Laois County Council examine and consider what extra safety measures can be taken on the R 430 on the straight stretch of road which is over 1 km long at Dromagh, Sallysbridge and Newtown as the speed of cars are making it very dangerous for residents entering/ exiting their homes and is becoming unsafe for people who walk or cycle this road . There are over 50 residents on this road”
