“That Laois County Council install a public light on Lea Road outside Portarlinton at the turn off for Lea Castle”

“That Laois County Council implement a safety scheme at the blind bend at the junction of the R420 and R424 at Kilmullen, Portarlinton”

Consideration to the installation of a flood ramp outside the homes for further protection should be examined. Also, to consider the re-strengthening and re-surfacing of the road at Ratheniska”
