145. PART VIII OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, 2001 IN RESPECT OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF FOUR NO. TWO BAY HALTING SITES AND ALL ASSOCIATED WORKS AT OAK PARK, KNOCKMAY, PORTLAOISE, CO. LAOIS.

On the proposition of Councillor Caroline Dwane Stanley seconded by Councillor John Joe Fennelly, the Members unanimously agreed to the proposed construction of four no. two bay halting sites and all associated works at Oak Park, Knockmay, Portlaoise, Co. Laois.

146. DISPOSAL OF LAND UNDER SECTION 183 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 2001 IN RESPECT OF DISPOSAL OF 0.108 HA (SITE NO. 13) AT CASTLETOWN, COUNTY LAOIS

On the proposition of Councillor Caroline Dwane Stanley seconded by Councillor James Kelly, the Members unanimously agreed to the disposal of land comprising 0.108 ha (Site No. 13)) at Castletown, County Laois in the townland of Churchfield, Co. Laois for a consideration of €30,000.00

147. DISPOSAL OF LAND UNDER SECTION 183 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 2001 IN RESPECT OF DISPOSAL OF FREEHOLD INTEREST COMPRISING 0.163 HECTARES AT THE GLEBE, COOLRAIN

On the proposition of Councillor James Kelly seconded by Councillor Conor Bergin, the Members unanimously agreed to the disposal of freehold interest comprising 0.163 hectares at The Glebe, Coolrain, Co. Laois in the townland of Glebe for a consideration of €1.00

148. CAPITAL INDICATIVE PROGRAMME 2021~2023

The Members were presented with the Three Year Capital Indicative Programme 2021~2023 in accordance with the provisions of Section 135 of the Local Government Act, 2001 setting out the capital projects over each of the three years under the main headings of Housing, Roads, Climate Action, Flood Relief, Amenities, Urban & Rural Regeneration, Town & Village renewal, Libraries and Fire Services. The total estimated value of the Capital Programme is just over €130 million, the objective of which is to advance the physical, economic, social and cultural development of the County. The estimated contribution by income streams is as follows:

State Grants	€112,775,511
Borrowings	€12,538,191
Development Contributions	€2,087,500
Other	€2,986,000
Total	€130,387,202

It should be noted that the delivery of the projects listed in the capital programme depends very much on the level of state aid to Laois County Council. The members welcomed the investment in the County and the Directors of Service and Head of Finance responded to the various queries raised.

The Members were circulated with a copy of the Annual Service Delivery Plan 2021 and same was unanimously agreed on the proposition of Councillor Paschal McEvoy seconded by Councillor Ollie Clooney.
