On the proposal of Councillor Lodge seconded by Councillor Dwane-Stanley, the minutes of the meeting held on the 13th December, 2017 were confirmed and circulated

2) MATTERS ARISING.

Further to query from Cllr. William Aird in relation to recent flooding, Mr. Wes Wilkinson confirmed that locations identified, i.e. Boughlone, Harpur's Lane, were currently being inspected and works would be progressed over the coming weeks.

Mr. Kieran Kehoe, Director of Services, confirmed to the meeting that LCC were currently preparing a detailed submission to DTTaS.

Cllr. Catherine FitzGerald requested confirmation that gritting/salting was carried out in accordance with standards on 16th/17th January 2018.

Mr. Kieran Kehoe, Director of Services, confirmed that salting was carried out at 3:00 pm and 8:00 pm on 16th January 2018 and again at 8:00 pm on 17th January 2018. The Duty Engineer monitored the situation and as rain was forecast salting was not carried out as rainfall would negate the effects.

Cllr. William Aird requested that the Winter Maintenance Route Map be circulated to the Portlaoise MD prior to the next meeting.

Cllr. Caroline Dwane-Stanley requested that a small area of road on LHS of Ballyfin Road, Portlaoise appears to be subsiding and requires attention. Mr. Wes Wilkinson, SEE, to investigate.

3) IBAL RESULTS FOR PORTLAOISE.

The IBAL results were circulated and it was noted that Portlaoise was ranked \mathbf{n}^{th} out of 40 of the towns/cities surveyed.

Mr. Kieran Kehoe, Director of Services, recognised the work of LCC staff, Tidy Towns, Residents Associations and Downtown Traders and also the considerable investment of LCC in purchasing/maintaining planters.

Cathaoirleach Mary Sweeney congratulated all involved and noted Cllr. Jerry Lodge's contribution through his work with Tidy Towns.

Cllr. Jerry Lodge noted the rise of Portlaoise from 40 to 11 and complimented all involved. However, he noted that fly tipping/illegal dumping was becoming too common and this problem needed to be addressed.

Cllr. Noel Tuohy noted the IBAL results and advised that same were a credit to all involved.

Cllr. William Aird extended his congratulations to all involved in achieving such results and also thanked the traders for the efforts made. Cllr. Aird added that a quicker response time is required when dealing with reports of illegal dumping on the periphery of Portlaoise Town. Increasing the number of CCTV could be considered.

Cllr. John Joe Fennelly congratulated LCC staff and all those involved in achieving such results on his own behalf and on behalf of Abbeyleix Tidy Towns.

Cllr. Catherine FitzGerald also recognised the hard work carried out by LCC, Tidy Towns, Residents Associations, Downtown Traders which resulted in such improved IBAL results.

Cllr. Caroline Dwane-Stanley noted the results and wished to convey her congratulations to all involved. Cllr. Dwane-Stanley informed the meeting that she had been informed litter problems associated with the David Allen Billboard at the junction of Mountmellick Road/Station Road. Cllr. Dwane-Stanley requested that LCC contact the operator and advise of issues with littering as a result of 'posters' falling from billboard.

4) RIVER TRIOGUE CYCLEWAY BLUEWAY

Mr. Kieran Kehoe, Director of Services, presented proposals in relation to the River Triogue Cycleway Blueway and advised that LCC were successful in securing €99,500 funding for Phase 1 of the Triogue Cycleway Blueway. This would commence at the corner of JFL Avenue continue to the Peoples Park and towards the School Campus. LCC are currently finalising the design. Mr.

Kehoe was pleased to state that this would be the first project to be advanced under the Portlaoise Vision Statement 2040.

Each member of Portlaoise Municipal District wished to convey their congratulations to LCC on securing funding to promote such a facility and complimented all involved.
