6. School Sustainable Travel Study of Portlaoise: - Presentation by An Taisce

Representatives from An Taisce gave the SPC Members a very comprehensive presentation on studies they have carried out on travel patterns in and around Portlaoise town. The presentation was very well received by all and the work of An Taisce on the study was commended by the Members. Mr. Simon Walton confirmed that the outcomes on the various studies will be integrated, as appropriate, into the various Smarter Travel works programmes.

7. Hedgecutting

Mr. Adrian Barrett gave a presentation on hedgecutting in the county with a view to agreeing a policy on hedgecutting and putting in place an Autumn Hedgecutting Programme. There was some discussion around hedgecutting.

Cllr Fennelly raised the issue of the cost of disposing of clippings at Kyletalesha and he claimed that the charges in Laois are greater than in other counties. Mr. Simon Walton agreed to investigate.
