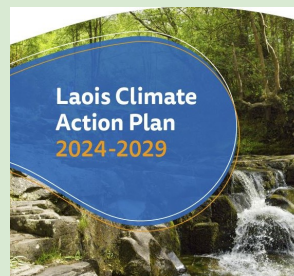

Laois Climate Action Plan 2024-2029

Back in January, we kicked off our exciting Climate Action Plan! This initiative is all about boosting our climate resilience, ramping up energy efficiency, and slashing greenhouse gas emissions. Portlaoise has been designated the Decarbonising Zone for Laois. Within the plan there are 62 actions for Portlaoise under 4 themes:

- Communications & Engagement Strategy
- Greening of Portlaoise
- Active Travel & Sustainable Mobility
- Decarbonisation Pathway and Circular Economy

Sustainable Innovation Course for Sustainable Enterprises and Communities

Learning and Collaboration Drive Climate Action in Portlaoise

Forty participants from 32 organisations and businesses are celebrating the successful completion of a pioneering course designed to equip communities with the skills needed to tackle climate change challenges. The Ireland's Knowledge Centre for Carbon, Climate, and Community Action (IKC3), in partnership with Laois County Council, conducted a pilot course titled "Systems Innovation for Sustainable Enterprises and Communities" (SISEC), focusing on the Portlaoise Low Carbon Town Project.

Delivered over three months, the course empowered local participants as challenge owners, providing them with the skills and knowledge necessary to address sustainability challenges within their communities. Participants engaged actively and collaboratively, applying systems thinking to tackle local climate change issues. The group has now formed the Portlaoise Climate Alliance, which will meet biannually to deliberate on the future of Portlaoise as a Low Carbon Town.

Midlands Park Volunteering Day

The staff from Midlands Park Hotel spent a day in the Linear Park in Portlaoise, removing Himalayan balsam as it is an invasive species.

It shades out native plants. It increases soil erosion as it dies back late. It produces a lot of nectar, which results in native species losing preference with the bees.

Portlaoise Low Carbon Town

Portlaoise has been selected to be a *demonstration town* for the implementation of sustainable and community driven urban renewal. Laois County Council are investing €2.7 million over the next three years to



increase:

- the resilience of infrastructural assets
- increasing Active Travel, with more cycleways
- building towards a 'Park and Stride' policy.

Trash Tree - Waste Characterisation

Litter collected by Portlaoise Tidy Town was painstakingly sorted in categories.

The goal? To get to the bottom of littering habits in the town centre. By pinpointing the main sources of litter, we can craft targeted anti-litter campaigns. The data will help Laois County Council decide on the type of recycling bins around town.



The art installation 'Tree of Trash' was created by artist Heather Roche. This multi-medium piece, inspired by the tree of life, uses litter collected by Portlaoise Tidy Towns as its foliage.
