SEAI will offer advice for grants and opportuniteis for homes, businesses and communities.


Monday and Tuesday, we will have an **EV car owner** to answer any EV queries.

Wednesday and Thursday **AEI solar panel experts** will be on the rig to answer any questions..



Smart Cities



The Climate Action Section and Caroline Hofman from The CUBE recently took a trip to explore the ins and outs of their Digtial Twin and Smart City initiative. Limerick City and County Council are keen to uncover deep retrofit options for the Georgian city centre complex. One of the coolest features? An interactive 3D model that streams real-time data from energy monitors in buildings all around Limerick City Centre.



New Mountrath Road Cycleway

Guess what? The Mountrath Road upgrades are finally done, and we're thrilled to share all the exciting details with you. These improvements are part of a grand plan to enhance the cycleways network across Ireland.

First up, we've reimagined the road space to include dedicated cycling lanes on both sides. The old footpaths? They're history! In their place, you'll now find sleek, 2-meter wide concrete walkways. And that's not all—we've added a new kerb to create a raised 2-meter wide cycle track, featuring Laois's very first red tarmac. How cool is that?

We've also made the junctions at two estate entrances safer by tightening them up and installing a raised pedestrian crossing. All these fantastic upgrades span a 300-meter stretch between Rockview and Rockdale estates.

Keep an eye out for more updates, especially about the upcoming Borris Road cycleways upgrade!
