

Decorating Safety Tips



Check lights and replace any broken or frayed strands

Place your tree at least 3 feet away from any heat source



Get your chimney cleaned at least once a year

Always turn off lights before leaving home or going to bed



Do not leave lit candles unattended

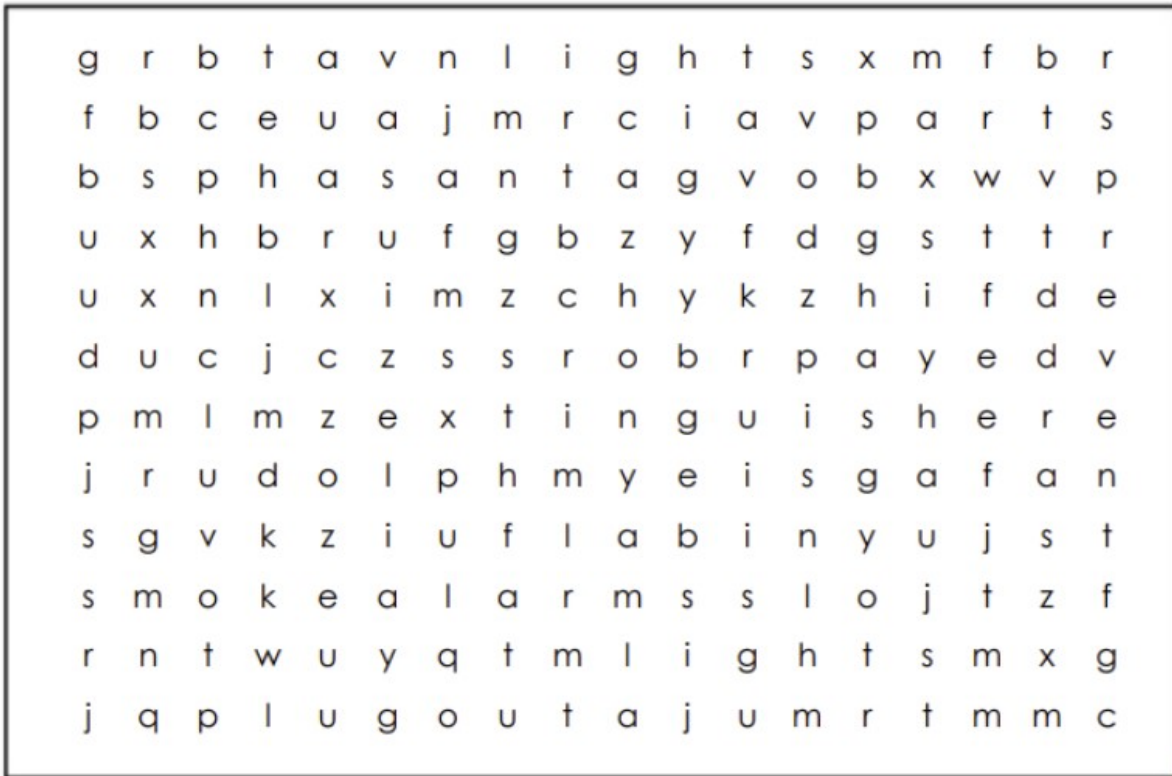
