

# Activity 5 - Scavenger hunt

This activity suits all ages and works in a forest, a park, or a garden too.

Things to keep in mind before you start:

- If you choose to collect some of the items (they may be useful for some of the other activity sheets), take only things that you can safely return without damage, and if you need to pick things, only take things that are common and no more than 1 leaf per plant. Do not collect the insects, please!
- Consider doing a litter pick while you are searching!

## Things to search for:

1. Something shiny
2. An asymmetrical leaf
3. Something stripy
4. Exactly 17 of something
5. Something camouflaged
6. Something that grew last year
7. Something beautiful
8. Something fluffy
9. Something bendy
10. Something that has been nibbled on by an insect/animal
11. Two types of seed
12. Something completely straight
13. A feather
14. Something that feels rough
15. Something you would like to find out more about
16. Something that smells nice
17. A sign an animal has been here
18. Something purple
19. Something symmetrical
20. Something that makes you feel happy
