“That Laois County Council replace the unsafe and uneven section of footpath outside Mitchell’s shop on Upper Main Street in Portarlinton”

“That Laois County Council arrange to cut a number of high trees at the rear of Station Court Estate in Portarlinton which are posing a serious risk to adjacent houses if they fall”
