Cruinniú na nÓg is a national day of creativity for children and young people (up to 18yrs) which celebrates and encourages participation in culture and creativity with free, local and activity-based events. Laois County Council Arts Office and Creative Ireland Laois wish to programme a series of workshops for **Cruinniú na nÓg** on June 12 that will inspire children & young people to make work based on the theme of '**A Sense of Place**'. Artists are required to be skilled and equipped in working online and facilitating online workshops, as well as pre-recorded video skills.

INVITATION TO APPLY FOR THIS GRANT SCHEME

Brief

1. Two workshop outputs are required from each proposed workshop

-A one-off live online workshop in a medium of your choice which could include painting, collage, illustration/drawing/graffiti, paper crafting, lego, mixed media, clay, digital photography, etc. (not more than 40 mins).

-A pre-recording of the workshop activity (not more than 15mins).

We plan to programme both the live and pre-recorded workshops in the lead up to Cruinniú na nÓg on June 12 and also on June 12.

Inspired by the workshop, children & young people will submit their finished work for competition. Successful entrants will have the opportunity for their work to be photographed and printed as an A5 (148mm x 210mm) postcard.

2. Your proposed workshop and facilitation should enable children & young people to.

-respond to 'A Sense of Place' brief

-learn about a new medium / media

-develop new skills

-create a piece for submission for competition,

-and if selected this piece would be photographed by Laois Arts Office and be suitable for distribution in postcard format.

3. Expression of Interest

Details of your proposed workshop in 1 A4 page only:

1. How does your workshop respond to the theme of 'A Sense of Place'
2. What is the medium you will work in and itemize the art materials required by participants for the workshop?
3. Identify what age group(s) your workshop is targeted at
4. Briefly describe your online arts workshop facilitation experience.
5. Provide up to 3 url links to existing online facilitated workshops/projects

In addition, submit your CV, and breakdown of costs

The budget per facilitated workshop (live online & pre-recorded) is a maximum of €600.
