Nomination Form



This form should be used to nominate a Group/Club/Organisation Only.

Groups/Clubs/Organisations can nominate themselves. Only one nomination permitted per group/organisation.

Groups cannot enter in multiple categories.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 1. To ensure judging is fair and impartial, Judges will be selected from outside of County Laois.
- 2. The nominated group/club/organisation must be well established.
- 3. Category winners are not permitted to enter the same category in the following year's awards.
- 4. The nominated group/club/organisation must be registered with Laois Public Participation Network prior to nominations.
- 5. The nominator may or may not be a member of the nominated group.
- 6. The nominated group should not be in receipt of regular State funding, e.g., regular grant aid. Should the nominated group have received a once-off grant for a particular item/project, this should be disclosed and will be judged accordingly.
- 7. The nominated group must have set out what they are about, highlighting their current/recent activities and achievements and the impact that all of their activities have on the local and wider community including, if appropriate, their level of participation locally and their level of volunteerism.
- 8. The nominated group must have set out what their plans are for the future, based on their commitment to making a difference in the community.
- 9. A minimum of two digital photographs must accompany the application form. Photographs should be of good quality and may be used for publication.
- 10. Groups can only be nominated in one category. Groups cannot be nominated multiple times across multiple categories.
- 11. If groups are nominated multiple times, the group will be contacted and asked to select which category they wish to enter.

 Again, only one application per group will be allowable with groups only being permitted to be entered in one category.
- 12. Nomination forms which don't have all the required consents from all individuals/groups involved will be deemed invalid.
- 13. Nominated groups will receive an allocation of two tickets only, with the nominator receiving one. Multiple applications will not increase a groups ticket allocation.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Groups will be judged by the Adjudication Panel based on the following criteria:

- Contribution of the group/club/organisation to the community;
- How representative the group/club/organisation is of the community;
- Level of voluntary involvement and participation;
- How well a group/club/organisation services and/or activities are planned and delivered, and the use of innovative approaches;
- Positive impact of the work of the group/club/organisation on the local and wider community;
- Positive impact the work has had on the target category, i.e., arts, community services & support, climate change, sports & recreation, etc;
- Use of inclusive working methods, e.g., reaching out to ensure that those who most need to actually get involved/benefit from inclusion;
- Future benefits to the community.

	This award is to recognise and celebrate group in our local communities from clubs, and community organisations that go above and beyond in their efforts to promote community sport and physical activity opportunities. This award aims to acknowledge groups or organisations that provide a leading role in their communities to help to improve the quality of life and reduce barriers to participation through physical activity or sports.
	Climate Action Award
	Award recognises communities carrying out awareness initiatives and/or actions that make a positive contribution against climate change. Climate actions can encourage your community to improve the impact of their everyday choices, support local communities and foster a sustainable approach to protecting the environment.
	Best Kept Residential Estate Award
	This award recognises the hard work and dedication shown in Residential Estates throughout Laois, recognises the great pride people have in their own communities, recognise the value of our biodiversity and continued to put in a huge effort, on behalf of the places where they live. <i>Please note that Tidy Towns groups are not eligible to be nominated under this category</i> .
	Social Inclusion Award
	This award recognises Clubs/Groups/Organisations that actively work in a supportive role in their communities and whose aim is to minimise social exclusion and/or help to improve the quality of life for socially excluded groups. Examples include Working with the elderly, People with Disabilities, Ethnic Minority, Travelling Community, Young people in transition, LGBTI+ and the Homeless.
	Health & Well Being Award
	This award recognises community health and wellbeing groups i.e., mental health, sexual health, awareness raising

& promotion around medical conditions, disorders and disabilities, increased meaningful daily activities, developing
