# 130. PART VIII OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, 2001 AS AMENDED IN RESPECT OF PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF 22 HOUSES AT BALLYMORRIS, PORTARLINGTON

The Members were circulated with the Planning Report on the proposed construction of 22 houses at Ballymorris, Portarlington. It was noted that the scheme comprises 22 units and support infrastructure including access road, public lighting, public footpaths, public and private open space, foul and surface water drainage and portable water supply. On the proposition of Councillor Tom Mulhall seconded by Councillor Aidan Mullins, the Members unanimously agreed to the proposed development.

## 131. DISPOSAL OF LAND UNDER SECTION 183 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 2001

### (i) Disposal of land at Togher, Portlaoise Co. Laois

On the proposition of Councillor William Aird seconded by Councillor Mary Sweeney, the Members unanimously agreed to the disposal of land at Togher, Portlaoise, Co. Laois in the townland of Togher, Portlaoise, comprising 5 hectares for a consideration of  $\mathfrak{S}_{925,000}$ 

## (ii) Lease of the Dunamaise Theatre & Centre for the Arts, Church Street, Portlaoise, Co. Laois

On the proposition of Councillor Noel Tuohy seconded by Councillor John Joe Fennelly, the Members unanimously agreed to the lease of the Dunamaise Theatre & Centre for the Arts, Church Street, Portlaoise. Co. Laois, in the townland of Maryborough by way of a Licence Agreement for a period of 4 years and 11 months for a consideration of €1.00 per annum

#### (iii) Lease of land at Rathmoyle, Abbeyleix, Co. Laois

On the proposition of Councillor John Joe Fennelly seconded by Councillor Padraig Fleming, the Members unanimously agreed to the lease of land at Rathmoyle, Abbeyleix in the townland of Rathmoyle, comprising of 1.6942 hectares for a period of three years for a consideration of €1.00 per annum with the condition that the lease be extendable at the end of the three years for a further period of 25 years.

### 132. PRESENTATION BY MS. AIDEEN ROCHE ON BEHALF OF LAOIS PARTNERHSIP AND THE LAOIS INTEGRATION NETWORK

Ms. Aideen Roche gave a presentation on behalf of Laois Partnership and the Laois Integration Network on the Laois Integration Strategy 2018-2023. Ms. Roche outlined the strategy development, public consultations, needs and challenges together with the specific actions for Local Authorities in the National Integration Strategy.

It was noted that the Strategy will be launched in October 2018. A questionnaire was also circulated to the Members for completion. The Members thanked Ms. Roche for a very informative presentation.

# 133. LAOIS COUNTY COUNCIL MONTHLY MANAGEMENT REPORT FOR JUNE 2018

Mr. John Mulholland, Chief Executive briefed the meeting on this matter and the report for July was circulated. The report was unanimously agreed and noted. A number of queries were raised on the report and the Directors of Services responded to the various queries raised.

Councillor John King, Cathaoirleach conveyed his best wishes and congratulations to Mr. Martin Keane on his appointment as Group Chairman of Glanbia and wished him every success in his new role.

#### 134. RATIFICATION OF CONFERENCES/ATTENDANCE AT TRAINING

The following item of correspondence was circulated to the Members which had been received since the last meeting:-

- (i) Correspondence dated the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2018 the Minister for Finance and Public Expenditure and Reform in relation to Notice of Motion No: 11/2018. Councillor Willie Aird expressed his dissatisfaction with the response
- (ii) Correspondence dated the 13<sup>th</sup> of July 2018 from the Minister for Health in relation to Notice of Motion No: 14/2018
- (iii) Email correspondence from Councillor James Kelly in relation to formally scheduling an agenda item for a full Council meeting to facilitate the members of Laois County Council to give due consideration to candidates seeking a nomination for the upcoming presidential election in October 2018.

This proposal was formally seconded by Councillor Ben Brennan. Councillor Kelly requested that Laois County Council meet within 7 days after the announcement of the election.

A query arose in relation to postal votes and the financial burden associated with the requirement of a medical certificate. It was agreed that a letter issue to the Department of Housing, Planning & Local Government in relation to same.

### Notice of Motion No: 15/2018

Councillor Willie Aird proposed the following Notice of Motion:-

"That Laois County Council be informed of the social housing delivery targets achieved to date in Laois under the 'Rebuilding Ireland' Programme"

This Notice of Motion was seconded by Councillor Mary Sweeney. The Members were advised as follows:-

Under the Rebuilding Ireland programme 2018 to 2021 Laois County Council has been tasked with delivering 627 social housing units. The target for 2018 is 76 units and it is expected that LCC will far exceed that target this year. Already in 2018 a total of 72 units have been delivered and a further 52 properties are at contract stage and will be delivered by the end of 2018.

The breakdown is as follows -

- 1. Construction 33
- 2. Acquisitions 17
- 3. Approved Housing Bodies 22 Delivered and a further 57 at nomination/final contract stage.

In addition, Mr. Mulholland advised that it is intended to hold an in-committee meeting for the members in relation to Re-Building Ireland and the Housing Programme at the end of August. This was agreed by Members.

#### Notice of Motion No: 16/2018

Councillor Ben Brennan proposed the following Notice of Motion:-

"That Laois County Council invite a representative from Irish Water to come down and explain why the pressure is being turned down and in some cases turned off completely in the Graiguecullen/Portarlington Municipal District Area"

This Notice of Motion was seconded by Councillor Caroline Dwane Stanley.

#### Notice of Motion No: 17/2018

Councillor Tom Mulhall proposed the following Notice of Motion:-

"That Laois County Council give an update on their plan for river maintenance in the County this coming year"

This Notice of Motion was seconded by Councillor Paddy Bracken. The Members were advised of the following for the three Municipal Districts

**(1)** The Borris in Ossory Mountmellick MD commenced vegetation removal works in February 2018 on both the Owenass and Murglash rivers in Cloncannon/Clonaheen area with similar works on the river Barrow and the Nore proposed to commence in August/September subject final to agreement with Inland Fisheries Ireland and National Parks and Wildlife. This work along with bank reinstatement works have required appropriate assessments, screening reports and walk over surveys which have been undertaken for various locations on the River Nore north east of Borris in Ossory (for a distance of 5.7 KM), the River Barrow at Rathcoffey, Reary valley and Irishtown to the Convent bridge Mountmellick town. Bank reinstatement works have already been undertaken at Barkmills, Bridge repairs/maintenance works are being Rathcoffey and Tinnahinch. carried out at Tinnahinch, Skerry, Water Castle and Cannon Delaney Bridge (ongoing).

- The Portarlington/Graiguecullen MD has completed appropriate assessment screening reports and walk over surveys for proposed works at various locations on the River Barrow north of Dunrally Bridge to the M7 Motorway, the Stradbally River between Stradbally and its confluence with the river Barrow and the Douglas river from its confluence with the River Barrow to the R-429. Vegetation removal works commenced on the Stradbally river in February 2018 with similar works on the river Barrow and the Douglas river due to commence on August the 7<sup>th</sup> subject to final agreement with Inland Fisheries Ireland and National Parks and Wildlife.
- (3) The Portlaoise Municipal District has completed appropriate assessment screening reports and walk over surveys for various works on approximately 8km of the River Nore in South Laois. A Natura Impact Assessment is also being undertaken for the reopening of one full arch, the removal of silt/debris and carrying out minor repairs to Newbridge at Cloncough, Shanahoe. Clearing of flow restrictions by undertaking the removal of vegetation, dead wood and tree pruning works on the River Nore have continued in 2018 following consultation with Inland Fisheries Ireland and National Parks and Wildlife.
