## ADDRESS BY THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE

Members were informed that the meeting would be of a maximum duration of 1hr 55mins. The meeting commenced at 11.00 a.m. Ms. Irene Delaney, Administrative Officer, Corporate Affairs briefly outlined the Member's statutory obligations concerning;

- Ethical Framework
- Disclosure at Meetings
- Disclosure in Advance of Meetings
- Planning Legislation

Mr. Pat Delaney, A/Director of Services advised the meeting of the Health & Safety requirements in relation to Covid-19.

Ms. Irene Delaney, A.O., Corporate Affairs referred to the Members statutory obligations regarding details concerning ethical legislation - Disclosure at meeting and Disclosures in advance of meeting, details of which had been sent to all Elected Members in advance of this meeting. Members were advised that if there were any further declaration of

interests that they should advise in advance of any discussion on that particular submission.

The Members were circulated with a copy of the Chief Executive's Report on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage of Public Consultation on the Draft Plan on the 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2021. The draft plan was on public display for a ten week period from the January 2021 until the March 2021. Mr. Joe Delaney advised that 154 submissions were received during the course of public consultation. The submissions will be dealt with an individual basis but have been grouped as they relate to a particular topic. This follows the structure of the Draft CDP 2021-2027. The Members were advised that in considering the matters in the Chief Executive's report they should take account of the following:

- any directions of the members of the authority or the committee under section 11(4),
- the proper planning and sustainable development of the area,
- the statutory obligations of any local authority in the area and
- any relevant policies or objectives of the Government or of any Minister of the Government and, if appropriate, any observations made by the Minister for Arts, Heritage, Gaeltacht and the Islands

Ms. Angela McEvoy Senior Planner made a short presentation and commenced the process of accepting or not accepting the CE response in relation to the issues raised.

Motion No 3 :- Rural Housing

## Proposal:

 Delete the section in the current Development Plan and the Chief Executive report on Rural Housing and Regeneration and replace this with the section on rural areas and rural housing strategies (including text and maps) in the Laois County Development Plan 2017-2023.

## Reasons:

- 3. The combined effects of the areas listed in the draft Development Plan and in the Chief Executives Report means that the vast majority of County Laois will be listed under areas of strong urban influence making it much more difficult for rural people to obtain planning in rural areas.
- 4. The current Development Plan had 3 categories of rural areas: Strong urban influence, strong Rural areas, and structurally weak rural areas. The proposal now is to reduce these 3 categories into 2 as follows: Areas under strong urban influence and structurally weak areas. This re-categorisation has meant that many of the areas that were categorised as strong rural areas are now being deemed as under strong urban influence.
- 5. The reference to: A member of the Rural Community has now been replaced by: An individual with a social or economic need to reside in rural Laois in the Chief Executives report. This is a fundamental switch.
- 6. Taking all the above points into account the move to include most of County Laois under an area under strong urban influence is not justified.
- 7. Since the current plan was introduced since 2017 many areas have had only a small number of houses built in the areas.
- 8. The proposal in relation in the Chief Executives report in the draft plan of people who need live in rural areas must reside within 8km or where they are from or their farm is excessively restrictive.
- 9. There are some small villages and settlements that are not listed in the Development Plan and there is no zoned land in these settlements, and it will be very difficult to get planning permission in these established settlements.
- 10. In many of the parishes throughout the county there may be one village deemed as a settlement in the Development Plan with zoned land that means most people from these areas will either have to live in the local village or go elsewhere outside their local community in the future.

- 11. If this continues it is guaranteed to be the last generation of people allowed to build and live in a home in the majority of rural areas in County Laois. This means many voluntary community and sport organisations/teams will only be for people in towns and villages in the future as there will be so few people living outside these areas after a generation.
- 12. All this approach totally ignores the importance of remote working, and it will ultimately lead to less numbers attending many rural schools and impacting community spirit in rural areas.
