Further to receipt of the licence application from EP Republic Ltd. I recommend the following conditions be attached to this application:

1. The applicant shall be in charge of all litter management for the town of Stradbally for the duration of the event (23rd – 27th September). Laois County Council will provide the applicant with a key to the litter bins in the town in advance of the event, to be returned to the Council on the Tuesday after the event.
2. The applicant shall ensure that litter bins are emptied on a regular basis and that any bins that are full are promptly emptied.
3. The applicant will be responsible for litter picking in the town of Stradbally for the duration of the event.
4. The applicant will be responsible for the collection and disposal of any refuse bags left in the public realm over the course of the event and, in particular, shall ensure that there is no build-up of refuse bags adjacent to litter bins.
5. The applicant must submit a detailed traffic management plan for review and approval by Laois County Council Roads Department. This traffic management plan should show the designated routes to the town of Stradbally that are required to gain access to the various site access points.
