# BALLYKILCAVAN HOP PICKING



Every autumn, the brewers at Ballykilcavan Brewery make a **unique Irish beer** using water, barley and hops sourced exclusively from the **380 year old**, **13th generation family farm** at Ballykilcavan, near Stradbally, Co. Laois.

This is the third year of the **annual hop picking event** where we select the best, tastiest hops **from the hop garden** behind the new brewery and then watch them being used to make the 2019 vintage of the Ballykilcavan fresh hopped pale ale.

Join us at 10am to get a **tour of the hop garden** and then help to pick the bittering and aroma hops straight from the bines. We'll collect them all together, and then bring them back to the brewery (which is only 400 metres away), and you can **experience the smells and sounds of a full brew day** as we add the freshly collected hops to the beer.

While the brewers are working away, there'll be a **BBQ lunch** and a chance to enjoy a few Ballykilcavan beers.

Free entry and suitable for all. Please bring wellies or good footwear and a pair of gardening gloves.
